

RV PARKING INFORMATION

RV owners need to be aware of regulations pertaining to RV parking in Vermilion. There are provisions for parking an RV on the street which must be followed for the safety of everyone using the road way. An RV is allowed to park on the street for a period of 48 hours, once per 7 days, providing provisions have been met.

EXAMPLE:

You can park your RV on the street Wednesday and Thursday in preparation to leave for camping on Friday. However, you cannot return and park the RV on the street on Sunday night expecting to keep it there throughout the rest of the week.

The RV cannot be parked in a manner which constitutes an obstruction, presents a safety concern, or impedes the progress of other users of the roadway, highway, or highway right of way. Examples of this may include, but may not be limited to: An RV which obstructs a sidewalk, protrudes into a traffic lane, inhibits motorist vision, or is parked on a crosswalk. The RV must be attached to a vehicle when left on the street during the 48 hour provision.

In addition, an RV can be parked in a residential driveway providing it does not overhang into the sidewalk/roadway. The RV could be parked on an empty lot, providing the landowner has given consent and can be verified by Vermilion Municipal Enforcement.

When a RV is parked on the street, electrical cords must be raised to a height of 2.4 metres by sturdy poles or stanchions. This will prevent the possibility of pedestrians tripping on electrical cords.
