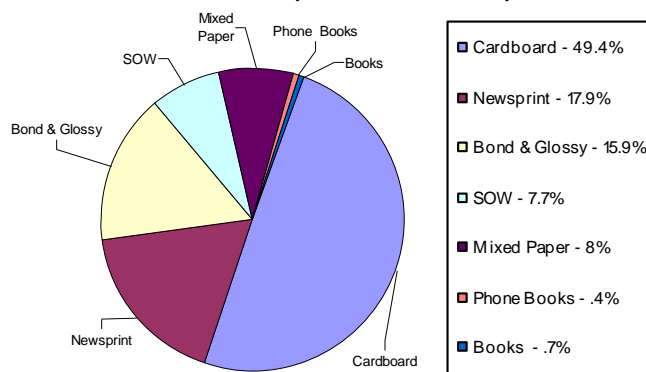


Thank you for using the Vermilion Recycling Program. Our program is made possible through a recycling levy on the Town of Vermilion Utility Bills and through the sale of processed material.

The goal of our recycling program is to reduce the amount of solid waste material that is transferred to the Beaver Regional Landfill each year.

The residents of Vermilion recycle an average of 16% of their residential household garbage. That is 468 tonnes of recycled material processed each year. Just in the last five years our recycle centre has processed over 2,300 tonnes of material – That is equivalent to 287 loads of grain!

Our recycle centre processes paper, plastics and tin products. The majority of recycled material brought to the recycle centre has been paper products. It makes up more than 94% of the recycled material each year.

# Vermilion Recycle Centre

We welcome all local and out of town residents to bring their recycled goods to our centre.

## Plastic Products

### Plastic Milk Containers

- All Milk containers, rinsed and caps removed

### Plastic Film

- Grocery bags
- Bubble wrap
- Boxboard liners



### Other Household Plastics

- Other pre-rinsed plastic containers, lids removed
- Ketchup, margarine containers, etc.
- Detergent containers

If you are unsure if a plastic container is recyclable, please bring it to the Recycling Centre for us to determine.

## Tin Products



### Tin Cans

- Labels removed and rinsed thoroughly

## Ink Cartridge



### Ink Cartridge

- Ink Cartridges are now accepted at the outside bins

## Glass Products

Please note that the Vermilion Recycle Centre does not accept glass containers.

We are currently unaware of any facilities accepting glass in this area.



## Paper Products

All newspapers, magazines, and loose paper must be bundled or bagged and tied securely. Wet or soiled paper products cannot be recycled.

### Newsprint

- Newspapers
- Non-glossy flyers



### Glossy Paper

- Magazines and catalogues
- Flyers with a glossy finish

### Telephone Directories

- All telephone directories

### Office Paper & Mixed Paper

- All clean bond white paper
- Postcards & carbon forms

### Books

- Paperback books
- Hardcover books



### Corrugated Cardboard

- All corrugated cardboard, flattened

### Boxboard

- Cereal boxes, liner removed and flattened
- Cardboard milk cartons, rinsed and flattened

## Green Bins

From May to October local residents can use the green bins that are placed throughout town to easily dispose of yard waste (garden waste, grass clippings and leaves only). A map of the green bin locations can be found on our website.

Please dispose of your yard waste in its natural state. The only way we can make this compost program work effectively is if non-degradable garbage like plastic bags, tree branches, stumps, etc. are kept out of the bins. Please take these items directly to the Vermilion Transfer Station.

- Yard Waste
- Rolled Wire
- Metal
