## Vermilion Well Re-Entry & Repair Project Community Update

August 2017

### **New Playground Equipment to be Installed in Mid-August**

The Orphan Well Association (OWA) has given the Town of Vermilion the go-ahead to install the new playground equipment in the park in the Brennan sub-division. The two play structures are scheduled to be installed the week of August 14 and include swings, slides and various climbing components.

The original playground equipment was removed by the Town of Vermilion in the fall of 2014. This was done to clear space so the OWA could attempt to repair a leaking well in the area. At the time, the OWA committed to provide new playground equipment at a future date.

At the same time as the playground equipment is going in, an upgraded fence will be constructed around the well. This chain link fence, with privacy slats will help secure the well head and restrict access.

Installation of the playground, which will be done by Park N Play Design, will take two to three days to complete. During this time various pieces of heavy equipment will be in the area including a small bobcat, front-end loader and concrete mixing truck.

Every effort will be made to limit the disturbance to the community. Traffic in the area will not be restricted and operations will take place between 8 am and 6 pm, when possible.

As always, public safety is a priority for the OWA. At present, the small concentrations of gas from the well site do not present a risk to public safety, and are being closely monitored.
