Renew Your Pet Licenses for
2019



All pet licenses are due for renewal by December 31, 2018. We now have a range of options for your pet including lifetime licenses and reduced fees for animals with proof of microchip. If your animal is under six months of age, a junior license can be acquired for \$5 and needs to be replaced with a regular license after six months. **A fine of \$125 per animal will be issued after January 31 to anyone who fails to license their pet.** For more information about the approved Responsible Pet Ownership bylaw, find a copy on the Town of Vermilion website under Bylaws or pick one up at the Town Office.

WASTE MATTERS



Quick Pick has reported an increase of contamination in the Blue Bags. Please note the following items are **not acceptable** in the Blue Bag program.

GLASS - Broken glass is a very serious safety concern for handlers. Please take any wine or liquor bottles directly to the Bottle Depot for your deposit return.

Pizza Boxes - Food waste and grease stains contaminate the cardboard. Please dispose of them in your regular garbage.

Residual Waste - Containers and bottles **must be rinsed** of all residue prior to recycling.

Cat Litter - must be disposed of with your regular garbage.

Party Plates, Cups and Napkins - Items made from recycled material cannot be processed a second time. Food waste and residue left on these items contaminate your blue bag.

Ink and Electronics - Ink cartridges and electronic devices are not recyclable through the blue bag program. These items can be taken to the Vermilion Bottle Depot at 4612-48 A Avenue or to the Vermilion Transfer Station.

The blue bags are manually sorted and some of the items can be hazardous to the people sorting the material. Contaminated material cannot be processed into a recycled product. Your blue bag will not be picked up if it contains contaminated items.

Proposed 2019 Utility Rates

Council for the Town of Vermilion has approved the utility rates for 2019. These rates will be in effect on the January bill which will be sent out February 2019.

Water Flat Rate

Residential - Increase from \$33.75 to \$34.93/month
Commercial - Increase from \$41.09 to \$42.53/month

Water Consumption Rate

Res/Com. - Decrease from \$3.45 to \$3.38/m3

Sewer Flat Rate

Res/Com. - \$9.31/month

Sewer Consumption Rate

Res/Com. - \$1.45/m3

Garbage Rate

Residential - No increase - Remains at \$4.51/pickup
Commercial - Increase from \$19.62 to \$20.02/pickup

Recycle Rate

Residential - No increase - Remains at \$3.00/month
Commercial - No increase - Remains at \$18.75/pickup
