BYLAWS

Bylaw 11-2019 Debenture for Aerial Platform Unit for Fire Fighting

Council of the Town of Vermilion having given first reading to Bylaw-2019 on September 3, 2019 and having advertised and received no petitions against the planned borrowing passed second and third reading with two amendments of Bylaw 11-2019 Debenture for Aerial Platform Unit for Fire Fighting.

Bylaw 11-2019 amendments will include the following changes:

1. Amend the terms to replace “Ladder Fire Truck” to read “Aerial Platform Unit”.
2. Amend the terms to add the words “up to” in front of the amount that is to be borrowed. This addition permits the municipality to borrow any amount up to the \$1,092,000 set out in the bylaw.

Proposed Subdivision – Plan 142 3597, Block 2, Lot 1

The water and sewer service installation is currently underway and the storm service will be installed in the spring. Construction is expected to begin in June.

Vermilion Public Library usage report

Borrowing of material is up for the first time in years in all categories.

Facility usage: 162 basement bookings; 413 Technology help sessions; 85 research projects; 1,473 public computer sessions and 45 people visit on average per day.

Library programs: 2,944 people attended a program; 166 program sessions were offered.

Library memberships: Town residents 659, County of Vermilion River 297, other areas 72.
