BYLAWS

Bylaw 14-2019 Land Use Bylaw Amendment

Council of the Town of Vermilion passed first reading to amend Bylaw 11-2013 to address legislation to control and regulate micro cannabis production. In accordance with Section 692 of the Municipal Government Act, 2000 RSA, ch. M-26, as amended. A Public Hearing will be conducted on December 3, 2019 at the Regular Council meeting. The Public Hearing advertisement will be published in the Vermilion Standard on November 13 and 20, 2019.

Bylaw 14-2019 amendment will include the following additions:

1. “Micro Cannabis Production Facility” means an indoor facility not exceeding 200 sq m (2,152 sq ft) of canopy area involving growing, processing, cleaning, packing, distribution, and/or storage of cannabis or cannabis products. This does not include Cannabis Sales or Cannabis Production Facility as elsewhere defined and provided for in this Bylaw.

2. Addition of the following new section:

2.14 Micro Cannabis Production Facility

- i. There shall be no more than four (4) Micro Cannabis Production Facilities in operation at any given time within the C4 Shopping Centre District.

3. Addition of “Micro Cannabis Production Facility” to the following land use districts:

Section 3.12.3, being the discretionary uses of the C4 – Shopping Centre District.

NEW BUSINESS

Mechanical Lift Disposal Tender

The Single Basket Lift used at the Vermilion Regional Centre was advertised for tender after being replaced. The Town received one tender for \$1,325.00 plus GST which was accepted by Town Council.

Memorandum of Understanding (M.O.U.) – Vermilion Provincial Park

The Town of Vermilion is negotiating with Alberta Environment and Parks regarding maintenance and operation of the Vermilion Provincial Park campground. Council passed a motion agreeing to enter into an M.O.U. with Alberta Environment and Parks towards an agreement that would include a subsidy to ensure that the town would not incur a deficit in the first three years.
