By-law 1-2020 – Land Use Bylaw Update

The Planning & Development Committee, along with consultant Greg Hofmann, began the review of the existing Land Use Bylaw in 2018. The bylaw is reviewed and updated approximately every five years to stay current with industry and provincial regulations. A draft version of the new Land Use Bylaw 1-2020 was presented to Council for review and consideration of first reading.
